For F.Y. 2015-16

The collating of this data for FY 2015-16 is under process and would be made available in the public domain as and when ready by placing on IEA's website, as also distribute during the 2016 Annual Conference (99th).

2. Number and names of the terminated or expelled life member of the IEA, if any, since 2012 till date:

Since 2012, 1 (one) member has been expelled so far from IEA's Life Membership. His name is Dr. Ghanshyam N. Singh (yourself), erstwhile bearing IEA's membership number BR-420.

3. Cause or Causes of termination or expulsion of life members from IEA:
